
- Please continue to pray for the new medical clinic as it prepares to open this fall.

SO MUCH GOOD NEWS!

There are so many incredible things that happened this summer and so many more that are happening this fall at Samaritan Village, there's just not enough room to write about all of them in this newsletter. But, here goes. . .

Medical Clinic Opens this Fall

That's right! The medical clinic received its license in June and preparations are being completed for the opening this fall. The clinic will offer services for the children at the orphanage as well as those in the surrounding village. There will be two part-time doctors on staff, each rotating shifts. There will also be at least two nurses. There will be a complete pharmacy with both over-the-counter and prescription drugs available.

The services offered at the clinic will be similar to what you would find in an urgent care facility. And, thanks to a generous donation from Germany, an ultrasound machine has just been delivered to the clinic.



More Good News! The board has been praying for a doctor from here in the States, who is familiar with health care in Africa, to help us in making sure the clinic is staffed and run properly. This includes making certain the

right equipment and procedures are fully in place before opening.

God answered that prayer through a member on the team from Calvary Chapel Yuba City that worked at the orphanage in June. Dr. Mallet Tuekpe traveled with the team to Arusha. Dr Tuekpe (Mallet) is from Ghana, Africa and has been in the USA for twelve years. While at the orphanage he was able to meet with the doctors who will be part of the clinic as well as with Josephat to discuss some of the things that will be needed to make the facility the best medical clinic possible.

Mallet has pledged to continue to work with the clinic to ensure that it runs smoothly and efficiently to not only deliver quality medical care but to be a light that spreads the Gospel to all who come through its doors.

Calvary Chapel Yuba City Volunteer Team

Nineteen members from Calvary Chapel Yuba City traveled halfway around the world to volunteer at Samaritan Village. Ranging in age from eighteen months to over sixty, the team members spent nearly two weeks with the children and completed several projects. The team worked alongside the staff as well as the

children using nothing but hand tools to complete the work. Here are some of the major projects that were completed.

New Playground/Soccer Field

Thanks to some generous donations from Adventure Church of Yuba City and an individual donor, the children now have a new playground! It includes a giant play structure with several slides, various size swing sets and a zipline. The team also made a new basketball backboard combining the flags of the USA and Tanzania. A soccer field was also created below the playground area.

New Bunk Beds

Eighteen sets of bunk beds were assembled and added to rooms in the new building. The older children moved in immediately. The added rooms gives the orphanage space to take in more abandoned children.

New Drainage Ditch

The team spent a day digging a much-needed drainage ditch to prevent the run-off water from the fields from flooding the orphanage grounds every rainy season.

New Hope for John and Others Like Him

One of the CCYC team members (Desiree) is a special education teacher and another (Jenny) is a sign language interpreter. God used both of them to help John, an orphan who has grown up at the orphanage. Because of what happened to him as a baby, John is unable to speak. He was taught sign language but no one at the orphanage knows sign language. That's why our team members were such a blessing to him. While Jenny communicated to John in sign language, Desiree put together a notebook based on a method that uses pictures to enable John to communicate with anyone. The method is also available as an app on a tablet, so we are preparing to send this to John to make it even easier for him. Josephat is looking into having Desiree return to teach this method to special education teachers in Tanzania.

New Murals to Decorate the Nursery/Primary/Dining Room Walls

The team painted murals on the dining room and nursery room walls.


